Effie B. Creamer Scholarship

The Effie B. Creamer Scholarship was established in 1991 when Dr. Creamer retired from teaching at EKU. A group of former students, friends, and family of Dr. Creamer began the fund in honor of her commitment to the profession of teaching and her dedication to the student.

The scholarship is to be presented to an outstanding graduate student in the Community Nutrition Program. The student should be finishing the classroom portion of the graduate program and ready to begin the supervised experience component. Interest from the fund will be used as a cash award for the student to help defray costs of travel, lodging, and attire necessary to complete the practical experience.

Eligible students should apply for the scholarship during the semester prior to the beginning of their supervised experience. Selection of the recipient is to be made by the Foods and Nutrition Faculty at Eastern Kentucky University. A cash award is made to the student. The amount of the award is approximately \$250 and will be presented in the Spring to a student beginning the supervised practice in August.

Criteria for selection of the scholarship recipient will be:

1. Financial need.
2. Potential for success in the profession.
3. Preference will be give to a U.S. citizen.
